- 6. It is to be a constant love, not "come and go," not impulisve, spur of the moment kind.

## II. WHAT IS IMPLIED/INDICATED IN THIS KIND OF LOVE?

- 1. It is not some kind of "equal love" for all people regardless of circumstances.
  - Some people are hurtful and dangerous.
- 2. This kind of love is to be a mutual love as one person does another good, then that person should do good to the one who did good to him/her.
  - Children should love their parents who have loved them first.
  - Those in charge should love those under them and those under leaders should love the leaders.
  - Teachers should love their students and students should love their teachers.
