3. A time to be honest about ourselves before God.
 - *Luke 22:33*
 - How far we are actually willing to go for the Lord.
4. A time to actually turn from our sins.

III. A TIME FOR MEDITATION ON JESUS CHRIST'S DEATH

1. *1 Corinthians 11:26*
2. A time to take a deep look at Christ's death and it will indeed change us.

IV. A TIME FOR HUMILITY

1. *Luke 22:24-27*
2. The disciples argued among themselves about which one of them was the greatest.
3. Pride fills so there is no room for humility.
4. Jesus washed the feet of His disciples as an example for us to follow.
