#### **CHARACTERISTICS OF A TRUE SERVANT**

#### Mark 10:32-52

#### (Not entirely original with me)

**Introduction:** What/who is a servant? A waitress, a mechanic, a sales clerk, a store employee? In the days of Jesus a servant was a person who was "owned" by someone and did whatever his/her owner demanded. Often called "slaves." "Servant" is someone who tends to the needs of others in the best definition. If hiring someone, what qualities would you look for? However a spiritual servant would be someone who "ministers," serves others in the spiritual realm. How is a true servant of the Lord recognized? A true servant is recognized by the way he/she acts when he/she is treated like a servant. Believers are called "servants" of the Lord Jesus Christ.

## I. A TRUE SERVANT GIVES UP WHAT IS BEST FOR HIM/HERSELF

## 1. Mark 10:32-45

- 2. Jesus told His disciples over and over that He was going to be persecuted and would die on a cross.
  - The disciples thought that Jesus was going to set up His Kingdom.
  - Peter even scolded Jesus.
  - The disciples argued among themselves as to who was the greatest among themselves.
    - James and John asked Jesus to give them high places of authority in His coming Kingdom.
    - Jesus told them that if they wanted to be great, then they must be a servant and slave to all.
  - Jesus was going to Jerusalem to die but the disciples thought He was going to set up His Kingdom.
- 3. James and John were expecting favor from the Lord but didn't understand that it would cost them.
  - They thought all the people would bow to and accept Jesus as their King but instead He was spit upon, mocked, given a crown of thorns and hung on a cross.
- 4. Jesus did not come to be served, therefore it is wrong for any of His followers (believers) to seek to be served.
  - Believers should dedicate their lives in service to others, putting others interests over their own.
  - "...We have come to know love by this: that Jesus laid down His life for us; thus we ought to lay down our lives for our fellow Christians..."
- 5. Jesus chose to suffer unjustly for the sake of others, for the sake of the Gospel.
  - A true servant will allow others to treat him/herself unfairly for the sake of the Lord Jesus.
  - Why should a servant surrender what's best for him/herself?
    - A true servant wants others to receive first place and promotes them over him/herself.
      - It is not self-punishment but it is deliberately placing others ahead of him/herself.
    - If a true servant places others ahead of him/herself, he/she will be taking last place.
- 6. True greatness in God's Kingdom is found in the true servant.

## **II. A TRUE SERVANT LOOKS FOR THE BEST FOR OTHERS**

#### 1. Mark 10:46-52

- 2. A man came to Jesus asking what did he have to do to have eternal life.
  - After asking some questions, Jesus told him to go sell everything and give it to the poor.
  - The man was rich and refused and went away disappointed. He didn't want to help others by giving up his things/wealth.
- 3. A blind man called out to Jesus for help.
  - The disciples told him to be quiet and not bother Jesus.
  - Jesus called for the man (Bartimaeus) to come to him.
    - The blind man threw off his cloak which he used to spread on the ground in front of him so others could toss money on it for him.
    - He got up and made his way to Jesus.
    - Jesus asked him twice what he wanted Jesus to do for him.
    - Jesus healed the blindness of the man and told him that it was faith that healed him and he began to follow Jesus after that, leaving everything behind.
  - The true servant always asks as Jesus did, "what do you want me to do for you?"
    - There are no "strings" attached to a true servant serving others.
    - A true servant expects nothing and asks nothing in return for his/her service.
- 4. What do YOU do for others, totally free? Have YOU ever asked, "What can I do for you?"
- 5. Who is servant at YOUR house?

# **CONCLUSION:**

- 1. Not everybody is a TRUE servant, not everybody is even a servant.
- 2. Most people want to be served and served immediately.
- 3. Is there someone in your life that could benefit from being served by YOU?
  Why not ask them "What do you want me to do for you?"
- 4. A TRUE Servant of the Lord Jesus Christ puts others first and serves all who have a need that he/she can meet.
- 5. A TRUE Servant of the Lord Jesus Christ wants to imitate the Lord in being of use to others.
