Introduction: Do you know anybody of royal descent? Are YOU of royal descent? Was there somebody in your family tree who was a king or queen? - 2. Christians are descendents of the King of Kings, they are the children of God.

 - It matters not one's earthly position, rich or poor, well or sick, give a person the grace of God in his/her heart and that person is becomes noble, royal, descendant of God.

IV. CHRISTIANS HAVE CROWNS

- 1. They don't wear them every day for their "coronation" day has not come yet.
 - Anointed, some of the authority and dignity of royalty, but not crowned monarchs yet, but their crowns are already made.
- 2. If one could enter into God's "secret store house" what wealth would one see?
 - Crowns beyond count that were inscribed with "Made for a sinner saved by grace whose name is..."

 - Christians may be despised now, laughed at now, be called hypocrites now, but no man-given title will ever damage or mar the dignity and honor of the Christian for God's opinion is what really matters.

- 1. It is thought that kings never have any sorrows or are poor or suffer as others do, however kings do suffer.
 - Remember king David and all his problems and difficulties?
 - He was hunted like a wild animal.
 - He wept for his son Absalom who was pursuing him.
 - He hid from king Saul, slept on the cold ground.
- 2. Christians, do not expect that because you are kings in God's eyes, that you are to have no problems or sorrows.
 - Satan will do all he possibly can to ruin your life, to render you useless for the Lord.
 - The world will hate you and ridicule you and treat you as filth, making your life as miserable as it possibly can.
