CHRISTIANS ARE TO HAVE A RENEWED MIND

Romans 12:16

Introduction: There are many things that happen to a person who believes in Jesus Christ. He/she is born into the family of God, he/she is forgiven of his/her sins, he/she is indwelt with the Holy Spirit, he/she is transformed into a new person and in all this he/she is to have his/her mind renewed. What exactly does it mean to have one's mind renewed and how does that happen and what is the purpose for a renewed mind?

I. CHRISTIANS ARE TO BE OF THE SAME MIND

- 1. What does having the same mind mean?
 - It is "being of the same mind toward one another."
 - It is "thinking the same thing."
 - It was frequently commanded to the early Christians:
 - in Rome Romans 15:5
 - in Corinth 1 Corinthians 1:10
 - in Philippi Philippians 1:27; 2:2-3; 3:16; 4:2
 - in all of Asia 1 Peter 3:8
 - When Christians are renewed in mind, they will start to have similar goals, aims and views.
- 2. How do Christians have the same mind?
 - By seeking the mind of Jesus Christ Philippians 2:5
 - Every Christian should try his/her best to develop and imitate the mindsset of Jesus Christ.
 - The more Christians become like Jesus, the sooner they become of "the same mind."
 - By setting one's mind on the things above Colossians 3:1-2
 - Each Christian should focus his/her attention more and more on spiritual matters.
 - Being distracted by worldly matters and human opinions will destroy oneness of mind.
 - Where there is not unity, someone is not setting his/her mind on Jesus and things above.

II. CHRISTIANS ARE TO HAVE A LOWLINESS OF MIND

- 1. What does being lowly of mind mean?
 - Not setting one's mind on high things:
 - Do not be haughty
 - Do not be too ambitious
 - Do not aspire to eminence
 - Don't become snobbish
 - To associate with the humble:
 - assoicatge with the lowly
 - accept humble duties, tasks
 - willingly adjust oneself to humble situations
 - take a real, genuine interest in people.
 - A renewed mind takes a concerted effort not to be snobbish or ambitious and is willing to be associated with humble tasks with and for lowly people.
- 2. How does one become lowly of mind?
 - By paying attention to what one learns from:
 - David's attitude Psalm 131:1-2

- Jeremian's warning Jeremiah 45:5
- Jesus' teachings Luke 22:24-27
- By examining what one has learned from:
 - Jesus' example Philippians 2:5-8
 - James' teachings James 2:1-5t
- When one has the mind of Jesus Chrit, his/her lowliness ofmind will be manifested (revealed) by the nature of his/her goals and the company he/she keeps.

III. A CHRISTIAN THAT IS HUMBLE OF MIND

- 1. What does it mean for a person to be humble of mind?
 - "Not being wise in one's own opinion.
 - Not thinking too highly of one's self
 - Not being conceited
 - Not thinking that he/she knows it all
 - Warnings from the Scriptures:
 - Solomon gives warnings Proverbs 3:7; 26:12
 - Isaiah gave warnings Isaiah 5:21
 - Paul gave warings 1 Corinthians 3:18
 - A renewed mind will maintain a strong sense of humility, an awareness that one has much yet to learn from God and others.
- 2. How does one become humble of mind?
 - By listening to what the Scriptures say/teach:
 - 1 Corinthians 8:2
 - The wisdom of the world is to God, foolishness 1 Corinthians 1:20
 - Not many are receptive to the Gospel 1 Corinthians 1:26
 - God has chosen to confound the arrogant in their wisdom o- 1 Corinthians 1:27-29
 - By adding knowledge and experience:
 - The more one learns, hopefujlly the more one will realize just how much he/she doesn't know.
 - The older one gests, the more he/she realizes just how little he/she really knows.
 - By the example of Jesus Christ:
 - Jesus was willing to submit to the will of His Father John 6:38; 5:30
 - Jesus didn't think so highly of Himself that He viewed equality with God something to brag about and exploit Philippians 2:6
 - By adopting the mind of Jesus Christ will go a long way to help maintain humility about one's self.

CONCLUSION:

- 1. The more one adopts the mind of Jesus Christ, and make it one's own:
 - The more one will think like Jesus.
 - The less one will be snobish and ambitious over the wrong things.
 - The more one will associate with the poor, the less fortunate.
 - The less conceited and arrogant one will be.
