I. GOD PROVIDED ABRAHAM A LAMB

- 1. God gave Abraham a son.

- 3. Abraham journeyed to Mt. Moriah.
- 4. Abraham prepared to sacrifice Isaac.
- 5. God stopped Abraham.
- 6. God provided a substitute, a ram.
- 7. Abraham's descendents were blessed.

II. GOD HAS PROVIDED MANKIND A LAMB

- 1. God gave Mary a Son.
- 2. God's Son came to become a sacrifice.
- 3. God accompanied His Son to the Cross.
- 4. God's Son was not spared as was Abraham's son, God's Son was sacrificed.
- 5. God had to turn His back upon His Son.
- 6. God raised His Son from the dead.
- 7. All mankind has since been blessed.

CONCLUSION:

- 1. No greater love has God ever shown to mankind than this: HE sacrificed HIS ONLY Son for mankind.
- 2. No greater love has God's Son ever shown to mankind than this: He willingly died that those who believe in Him might live.
- 3. No greater love can mankind ever show to God and His Son than this: To believe in and accept as Savior and Lord, God's ONLY begotten Son.
