I. A NATION THAT RECOGNIZES AND ACCEPTS GOD

- 1. A nation that recognizes that God is God, the God of creation, the God who made man, etc.
- 2. A nation that accepts God's statutes and commandments.
- 3. A nation that lives in compliance with God's laws.
- 4. America was once this kind of a nation.

II. GOD ACCEPTS THE NATION THAT ACCEPTS HIM (Acts 10:35)

- 1. God will fellowship with the nation that accepts Him.
- 2. God will bless the nation that accepts Him.
- 3. God will bring peace and prosperity to the nation that accepts Him.

III. NATIONS THAT REJECT GOD WILL BE HIS ENEMIES (Psalm 9:17)

- 1. God loves all people and makes every effort to bring everyone to Him.
- 2. Some nations refuse to acknowledge Him as THE ONLY GOD.
- 3. Some nations acknowledge God as just one of many gods.
- 4. God has prepared a place for all those who refuse His love and fellowship and that place is HELL.
- 5. God is not willing that any person perish. (He sent Jonah to Ninevah to remind them of HIM)
- 6. God's own chosen nation, Israel, turned from Him to idols and other gods and are still being punished to this very day.

CONCLUSION:

- 1. Nations are made up of families and God's invitation to a nation is given to individuals that make up families.
