1. Matthew 5:27-28; Ephesians 5:3-5

III. THE PRINCIPLE OF LOVE

1. 2 Thessalonians 3:10

- Every person has the right to work as he/she desires.

2. All who work are to be paid a fair wage.

1. Genesis 12:1-3

- Total trust in Almighty God for direction, provision and blessing.

2. God will bless those who obey Him.

V. A GOD-CENTERED EDUCATION

- 1. Ephesians 6:4
