- 1. Anyone can teach another WHAT to pray for and to SAY his/her prayers BUT only God can teach a person TO pray. Prayer is the cry of one's heart to God because of being oppressed.
  - By Sin.
  - By Satan.
  - By the Law.

## IV. GOD'S GRACE SENDS A SAVIOR AS SOON AS A SINNER CRIES OUT TO HIM

- 1. Grace appointed Jesus Christ to be a Savior. (Psalm 89:19)
- 2. Grace sent Jesus Christ to accomplish salvation. (Matthew 1:21)
- 3. Grace sends Jesus Christ to all who seek Him. (Jeremiah 29:12-14)
- 4. Jesus Christ is a great savior.
  - In His person.
  - In His work.

- In His efficacy "He shall deliver them..."
- In His intercession.
- In His dominion.
- In His second coming.

### V. GOD'S GRACE CAUSES BELIEVERS TO SPEAK THE SAME THING

- 1. No matter who is saved by God's grace, all speak the same thing.
  - Saved people speak about the merits of Jesus Christ.
  - Saved people speak about God's free grace.
  - Saved people praise God.
