- 1. Any American youth can one day become President.
  - Lincoln went from a log house to the White House.
- 2. Talent, perserverance, ability can take a poor person and make him/her a millionaire.
- 3. Equal rights for all has caused many immigrants reaching America with NO money, to rise to positions of great influence in finance, science, politics and religion.
- 4. When Paul wrote to Philemon (text), he encouraged Onesimus, the runaway slave, to be received back by his rich owner to be treated as a brother and no longer as a slave.
- 5. God is no respecter of persons and the Gospel is offered to all, regardless of who or what they are.

## II. SEPARATION OF CHURCH AND STATE IS WHAT MADE AMERICA GREAT

- 1. Jesus said to "...give to Caesar the things that are Caesar's and to God the things that are God's..."
- 2. America recognizes NO State Church, NO single, particular Church as the Nation's Church.
  - America's forefathers left a land controlled by religion.
  - America's forefathers fought and died for the right to worship as they wanted.
  - America's forefathers knew the evils of a Church governed by civil authority and of a nation controlled by religious powers.
- 3. America protects all religions and favors no particular one.

  - State-controlled Churches always mean darkness, spiritual deadness and ritual hypocrisy.
  - Christianity thrives in America because it is free! One can worship God as his/her conscience prescribes.
  - It will be indeed a tragedy if Churches ever lose this freedom.
  - America stands for the protection of all religions, even those which are unpatriotic.

## III. CHURCHES AND THE STATE (GOVERNMENT) FUNCTION DIFFERENTLY

- 1. The State's (Government's) functions are:
  - To preserve order, to see that right and justice prevail, to protect the weak and punish evil doers.
  - To uphold morality and decency.
- 2. The Church's functions are:
  - To preach the Gospel for the redemption of souls.
  - The Church is the conscience of the State (Government).

- The prestige and influence of a State (Government) are never higher than the spiritual power of the people (Church).

## IV. THE BEST CITIZENS OF AMERICA ARE CHRISTIANS

- 1. Christians are not free from obligations to the State (Government).
  - Christians should vote, become involved in politics, engage in the defense of the great country.
  - Christians should enjoy all the benefits of the great land of America.
  - It is not only a matter of duty that Christians be obedient to governmental and civic regulations, but it is a command from the Lord Jesus, Himself: "...render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's..."
- 2. Christians do not exist to produce loyal, law-abiding citizens.
  - Christians exist to win the nation of America to the Lord Jesus Christ, for spiritual regeneration ALWAYS results in national purity.
- 3. There are traitors, however, to America's constitution.
  - Racketeers and crooks.
  - Selfish, unjust politicians.
  - Spies who sell out their country.
  - Those who infiltrate America by becoming "citizens" with the intent of bringing harm.
  - All of the people who work against our nation's welfare and safety are despicable and should be de-naturalized and extrodited.
  - As long as these kind of people exist in America, they are a menance and a threat to the grandest and freest country in the world America.
- 4. Let every citizen of America bless God for this great country.
  - It is a paradise of plenty.
  - It is the bread basket of the world.
  - There is no beauty in all the earth that excells the beauty of America.
  - America is the land of the free amid a world of aggression and violence.
