1. Matthew 19:4

II. MARRIAGE IS THE GREATEST OF ALL EARTHLY INVOLVEMENTS

1. Matthew 19:5

- 2. A man and woman are to leave their parents (purse and apron strings)
- 3. A marriage is greater than parent/children relationships.
- 4. a marriage is greater than a job/business.

III. MARRIAGE IS AN UNCONDITIONAL COMMITMENT

- 1. Each makes a promise of faithfulness to the other.
- 2. Each makes a promise to care for the other, regardless whether it is in good or bad times.
- 3. Each makes a promise to share everything, all in their life together.

IV. MARRIAGE MAKES TWO IN GOD'S SIGHT, ONE

- 1. Two are joined together physically to become one.
- 2. Two become one socially by taking only one name.
- 3. Two become one biologically by having children.
- 4. Two become one spiritually, as Jesus is with His Church.
 - One family but with different roles.
