- 1. Jesus said: "...I am the way, the truth and the life...." (John 14:6)
  - "...I am the bread of life..." (John 6:35)
  - "...I am the light of the world..." (John 8:12)
  - "...I am the door..."(John 10:9)
  - "...I am the resurrection..." (John 11:25)
- 2. Jesus made promises:
  - "...My words shall not pass away..." (Mark 13:31)
  - "...whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst..." (John 4:13-14)
  - "...whatsoever ye shall ask in my name..." (John 14:13)
  - "...MY sheep hear my voice..." (John 10:27-28)
  - "...All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth..." (Matthew 28:20)
- 3. Jesus placed Himself above the greatest of all people, institutions, authority.
  - "...a greater than Solomon is here..." (Luke 11:31)
  - "...and if I be lifted up..." (John 12:32)
- 4. Jesus claimed to be equal with God and that God was His Father.
  - "...I and My Father are one..." (John 10:30)
  - "...My Father is working still..." (John 5:17-18)
- 5. Jesus claimed to be mediator between men and God.
  - "...all things are delivered unto me of My Father..." (Matthew 11:27)
  - "...Come unto me, all ye that labor..." (Matthew 11:28)
- 6. Jesus claimed to be judge.
  - "..."...I never knew you..depart from me..." (Matthew 21-23)
- 7. Jesus claimed to be the Son of God.
  - "...Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the right hand..." (Matthew 26:64)

# II. JESUS'S CLAIMS WERE PROVED BY HIS LIFE

- 1. Jesus made amazing claims and supported those claims by His amazing life.
  - For almost 2,000 years the claims that Jesus made have been preached and published all over the world.
  - Thoughtful, earnest people have responded to His claims and have found Jesus to be all that He claimed.
- 2. Jesus' life has been one of consistent humility, truer and modest even in the tremendous claims He made.
  - "...Come unto me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden..." (Matthew 11:28)

- "...I am meek and lowly..." (Matthew 11:29)
- 3. Jesus maintained His claim to deity.
  - Who else in human history could make such a claim and then maintain it?
  - "...Follow me be worthy of me I am the light of the world Ye are from beneath, I am from above..."
  - Jesus is far more than any other human who has/will ever existed.

## **III. JESUS' CLAIMS ARE SUPPORTED BY HIS THOUGHTS**

- 1. Jesus claimed to be the Son of God and He acted like God in all ways, physically, spiritually and mentally.
  - Jesus never had to repent for He never committed a sin.
