A DEFINITION OF A CHRISTIAN

Acts 11:26; 26:28 1 Peter 4:16

8. A Christian is as human as any other person.

- Christians make mistakes but have those mistakes forgiven and still has his/her reward and place in Heaven. Non-Christians do not!

9. A Christian is a soldier.

- Every day the Christian does battle with God's greatest enemy Satan.
- The Christian is protected by God as he/she encounters the enemy.
- The Christian will ultimately win, for Jesus has already defeated death, the grave, and Satan

10. A Christian can be anybody who qualifies.

- A child, a teenager, an adult, a boy, a girl, a man, a woman.
