#### John 8:32-36

## I. WE ARE ALL IN BONDAGE

- 1. We are under the curse of God's law.
  - God's law requires perfect, perpetual obedience.
  - God's law brings a curse for each violation (Galatians 3:10)
  - How many times have you violated God's law?
  - We are all, without exception guilty of breaking God's law and are under His curse.
- 2. We are under the power of sin.
  - Sin infects the body and soul like a consuming disease.
  - Who will dare say, "I have no sin, I have never broken God's law"?
  - Romans 7:14, 15, 223
  - When faced with the truth, do not all of us cry as Paul, "O wretched man that I am..."
- 3. We are under the tyranny of Satan.
  - Many try to deny that there even is a Satan.
  - Ephesians 2:21 states that God says our wickedness is of Satan.
- 4. We are under the fear of death.
  - Who has the so called "battlefield fearlessness?"
  - All around us are those watching death creep up, even some of us are just waiting for it.
  - Who does not think of death? Who thinks of seeing loved ones grow sick and death is coming for them? Who dares laugh at death?
- 5. We are enslaved, we are not free.
  - We are enslaved to the curse of God's law.
  - We are enslaved to the power of sin.
  - We are enslaved to the tyranny of Satan.
  - We are enslaved to the fear of death.
  - Can we ever be free of our enslavements?

## II. WE ARE IN BONDAGE BUT WE CAN BE FREE

- 1. Our attempts to free ourselves are useless.
  - We cannot satisfy our breach of God's law.
    - What can do away with our sins?
    - Hebrews 10:4, 11, 12, 14
  - We cannot renew or cleanse our own hearts.
    - We can't even think about Jesus.
  - We cannot resist Satan's attacks. Only God has more power than Satan.
    - Only God provides adequate protection (Ephesians 6:11, 13)
  - We cannot remove the sting of death.
    - What can we do? Where can we hide? Cannot ignore it.
  - We must admit, confess that it's just not within us to free ourselves.
    - To whom do we go? Who has the power to really make us free?
- 2. Jesus, the Son of God, is able and willing to make us totally free.
  - He came for the purpose of freeing us.
  - He took the law's curse for us, paid our penalties, bought us, freed us.
  - Jesus Christ with holds freedom from no one.

# III. TOTAL, COMPLETE FREEDOM COMES ONLY THROUGH JESUS CHRIST

- 1. Jesus Christ frees from ALL bondage.
  - The curse of God's law no longer claims us.
  - Sin's enslavement of us will be cast down and we will never be enslaved again.
  - Satan must yield to Jesus for .. greater is He that is within us than he that is in the world."
  - Death no longer has its' sting, no more need to fear it. We can actually look forward to it.
- 2. Jesus Christ will show us how to really be free.
  - He will live within all who call upon Him and trust Him with their total existence.
  - He will take our burdens away from us, will walk with us and will lead us into eternity.

## **CONCLUSION:**

- 1. How wonderful is Jesus Christ our Savior.
  - He will free all who call upon Him.
  - There is no price for us to pay.
  - It is His joy to free and save us.
- 2. Without Jesus Christ one is still enslaved with no hope of ever being free.
