GOD HAS A PURPOSE AND PLAN

I. GOD'S PURPOSE IS SEEN IN MANY WAYS

- 1. **He Will Judge:** God is showing **who** is the boss..(Isa. 14:26)
- 2. He Will Direct: God has plans in mind for each of us and will lead us if we allow. (Ro. 8:38)
- 3. **He Will Work Through Christ:** Christ has already done much but He has yet to set up His kingdom and rule the world for a thousand years and then bring things to an end. (Eph. 3:11)
- 4. **He Will Carry Out His Plan:** The purpose of God was set before the creation and will not be changed to or by something that man dreams up. (2 Tim. 1:9)

II. EVERYONE IS ON ONE SIDE OR THE OTHER OF GOD'S PURPOSE

- 1. Nothing Changes God's Purpose:
 - Prayer changes people and things but not God's purpose. (Dan. 4:35; 6:27; Phil. 2:13)
 - How many of us have questioned God when He didn't do as we expected and then got upset?
- 2. Which Side Of God's Purpose Are You On?
 - We can walk with Him, allowing Him to work His purpose and plans through and for us.
 - If we are God's children, He has a plan for us.
 - If we are nt allowing Him to work His plan for us, then He will bring things into our lives that will help us change our direction. Has God ever done this to you?

III. GOD HAS BEEN WORKING OUT HIS PURPOSE

- 1. "In beginning, God said..." God had a purpose and a plan:
 - God created the heavens and the earth.
 - God created man...
 - Man tried to trip up God's plan by eating forbidden fruit. God tripped man out of the garden.
 - God made clothes of skin. heading toward his goal of shed blood for man's sins...
 - Time wore on and man became wicke and .none but Noah found grace in God's eyes..
 - After the flood Mankind gathered at Babel with a purpose..to build a tower to heaven..this was not God's purpose so He scattered mankind across the face of the earth.
 - God called a man named Abraham to further His purpose of having His own Nation Family

- 5. God is active in teaching us. (1 Jn. 2:27) Everyday God reveals something about Himself to us.
- 6. God is active in providing our needs. (Mt. 6:33) Everyone of us can testify of God's provisions.
- 7. God is active in His time table. (Acts 1:7) (Isa. 40:31) Remember, God doesn't go by our timetable
