"GOD IS GOD!"

Genesis 1:1 Exodus 3:3-6; 13-14 Job 38:1-

Introduction: The words "God is God!" were uttered by Yule Brenner in his role as Pharoah in the "Ten Commandments" movie. After the plagues God sent to Egypt the Pharoah finally admitted that the God of the Israelites was indeed "the" God. As we live our lives we so often get caught up in the activities of life that we sometimes drift away from the realization that our God is indeed the true and only God and therefore we need to be reminded and reassured, our faith refreshed that the God of our Bible is indeed God. Let's take some time and refresh our faith by remembering some things about our great God.

- 1. God is Compassionate: He has a constant caring, interest, concern for ALL of His creation. He even knows when a single sparrow falls. How much more does He care for us, believers, children of His own family.
- **2.** God is Condescending: He allows, even invites His creation to communicate with Him (as with Adam and Eve); encourages us to PRAY with assurance that He will hear us.
- **3.** God is Faithful: He fulfills His Word, His promises, His covenants. He is an unfailing source of comfort and assurance to us, His children.
- **4. God is Good:** His natural character is to treat ALL His creation with kindness and has our best interests ALWAYS at heart, giving us ALL we ask for in line with what is best for us.
- **5.** God is Holy: He is righteous in ALL His ways. Holiness motivates His actions and holiness is visible in ALL that He does.
- 6. God is Immutable: He is self-existent, unchanging. God is and never will be more or less that what He is this very moment. A most assuring comfort. Our God can always be depended upon to remain the same.
- 7. God is Incomprehensible: Our minds cannot grasp His eternal existence nor His ways. He has had to use human terminology with us to help us grasp a minute degree of understanding about Him, (ear, hand, eyes, etc..).
- **8.** God is Just: He has absolute right and authority over ALL things since they exist by His creation and will. God will always deal justly and fairly with ALL of His creation. A most reassuring thought.
- **9.** God is Long-Suffering: A marvelous attribute which has contributed to the longevity of some of us on this earth. Also the fact that many turned to Jesus Christ after many, many years of resistance.
- **10.** God is Love: He is the unfailing source of ALL love. He could not be God without love. It is the primary motive of all that God does.

- **11.** God is Merciful: Even to the hardest sinner, He is still merciful and not willing for any to perish. The degree of God's mercy to us is seen at the Cross. If He so loved us when we were His enemies, how much more must He love us now that we are in His family.
- **12.** God is Omnipresent: His perfection demands that He be everywhere at the same time, otherwise He would not be God. He made space for THINGS and not being a "thing" He requires no space.
- **13. God is Omniscient:** It is from our God that all knowledge comes. He is the source of ALL information and fact. He comprehends ALL things past, present, future, possible, maybe, etc.. and our innermost thoughts.
- **14. God is Omnipotent:** All that is and ever was or will ever be came from God. Whatever He wills, happens. He has NO equal. He is the source of all authority and power.
- **15.** God is Sovereign: Since all things came from God, all things are subordinate to Him. Created things and REDEEMED things (us). It is God who has assigned everything to its respective place and purpose. It was not "Chance."
- **16. God is Truth:** Without being TRUTH, God would not be God. He would not be believable nor trustworthy. He has instilled within His creation the ability to recognize TRUTH>
