- Every single animal that ever has been when they live and when they fall/die. (Matthew 10:29)
- Every person that has ever lived and when they died. (Job 26:6)
- Every intimate detail of every person who has ever lived. (Jeremiah 1:5; Psalm 139:1-4; 15;56:8;

Job 14:16-17; Matthew 10:30; Proverbs 5:21; Isaiah 46:9-11)

- Before his/her birth through their earthly life to their death.
- Their every thought.
- The hairs on their heads to every deed ever done.
- Everything there was/is to know.
- Everything from the past to the future.

2. GOD'S KNOWLEDGE INCLUDES THE "WHY" THINGS ARE DONE

 - Our knowledge is uncertain, changes, incomplete.
 - The older we get, the more we usually learn.

5. GOD USES HIS KNOWLEDGE WISELY

- God uses His knowledge for good.
- God knows the past, present, and the future, knowing how to bring about His intentions.
- We don't use what knowledge we have very wise most of the time and have no idea what the future holds.

6. KNOWING ALL THINGS, GOD STILL GIVES PEOPLE FREEDOM TO MAKE CHOICES

- Deuteronomy 8:2; Genesis 18:20-21
- God tries to get people to see what they are really like.
- God cares about people and wants to see them do their best.
- God sends warnings at times to try to get people to do the right thing. (Proverbs 15:11)
- God even sends warnings to His own Children (Christians) and will even send correction on them.
- Knowing God cares for us, that knowledge should bring relief to the believer. (Matthew 6:8)
- Knowing that God knows our every thought and how we feel, that we (believers) are His Children, should cause us to be grateful and thankful.
