- God reveals Himself in such a way that it is indeed possible to have a fellowship with Him.

I. JESUS CHRIST IS THE MEANS OF GOD REVEALING HIMSELF TO PEOPLE

- 1. Jesus was continuously aware of God's presence throughout all His life on this earth.
 - At the age of 12, Jesus remarked to His earthly parents, "...I must be about my Father's business..."
 - Years later from the cross Jesus said: "...Father, into thy hands I commend my Spirit "
- 2. Jesus taught much, thus revealing a lot about God that most did not know.
 - God is very real. He is good, perfect, loving, fair, interested in everyone, knows all things, is merciful but is also Judge.
- 3. Jesus' character and life reflected His identity with God.
 - Jesus lived everything He taught. He was the perfect example of how God wants everyone (us) to live.
 - His unselfish love for sinners, the healings, casting out of demons, reflected God's character.
 - All Jesus did reflected God, the Father.
- 4. Jesus made claims concerning His relationship to God.
 - Jesus said that God had sent Him into the world to bring salvation.
 - Jesus said He had a special and private knowledge of God.
 - "...neither doth any know the Father except the Son..."
 - "...I know Him because I am from Him and He sent Me..."
 - Jesus claimed to be the only one who could reveal the Father.
 - "...I am the way, the truth, the life, no one comes to the Father except by Me..."
 - God reveals Himself to people ONLY through Jesus Christ.
- 5. Jesus' work was redemptive.
 - "...He came to seek and to save the lost..."
 - John 1:3, 14, 18

II. THE BIBLE AND THE REVELATION OF GOD

- 1. Jesus Christ is God's revelation to people.
- 2. The Bible, the Word of God is the record of God's revelation.
- 3. The heart of the Bible is the four Gospels.
- 4. Acts reveals God's Church that came from the Gospel.

- 6. The Book of Revelation describes the history from the Church beginning to the end of time.
