NOT EVERYBODY CAN WORSHIP

John 4:24; 14:6 Mark 7:6-7

Introduction: Churches have "worship" times posted on their marquees, listed in their bulletins, published in newspapers and printed on their witness hand-outs. People attend services in Churches that are called "worship" services. "Worship" can be defined as: to idolize, to love unquestioningly and uncritically. So, why are we here today? Why is this service called a "worship" service? Can anybody "worship" the Lord God?

I. GENUINE, TRUE WORSHIP OF THE LORD GOD IS EXCLUSIVE

- 1. "...and they that worship Him MUST worship Him in spirit and in truth."
 - There is no choice in the matter of worship given to people. There is but one way to worship the Lord God.
 - -"Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye MUST be born again."
 - "As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so MUST the son of man be lifted up."
 - Only those who have been born again and who are resting upon the atoning work of the Lord Jesus Christ can worship the Lord God.
- 2. "This people honoureth Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me. Howbeit in vain do they worship Me."
 - A person can be sincere, generous, zealous, devout, regular in attendance, yet be no more capable of worshipping the Lord God than a person without a tongue singing in the choir.
- 3. In order to worship the Lord God, God must be known and He CANNOT be known apart from Jesus Christ.
 - "I am the way, the truth, and the life; no man cometh unto the Father but by me..."
 - An unbeliever knows not Jesus Christ nor does he/she know God the Father and therefore cannot worship the Lord God.
 - A believer who is out of God's will cannot worship God, for his/her heart is far away from the Lord God.

II. WHAT IS GENUINE, TRUE WORSHIP?

- 1. "God is Spirit; and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in truth."
 - To worship in "spirit" is not having rites and ceremonies done by people.
 - To worship in "truth" is not bowing before or singing to or recognizing idols and superstitions.
 - To worship in spirit and in truth means GIVING to the Lord God from an enlightened and regenerated heart.

- 2. To worship in "spirit and in truth" rules out external and spectacular things. It rules out using the bodily senses.
 - God cannot be worshipped by just looking at stained glass images.
 - God cannot be worshipped by just listening to the sounds of a pipe organ.
 - God cannot be worshipped by just burning incense.
 - God cannot be worshipped by just fingering beads.
 - God cannot be worshipped with our eyes, ears, noses, hands or feet for those are bodily things, NOT spiritual.
- 3. To worship in "spirit and in truth" rules out people being the center of attraction in services.
 - Words/sermons from the preacher may be beautiful, touching, thrilling, beautifully accented and a well trained voice, but is not worship.
 - Beautiful hymns sung by a well-trained choir, that may move us to tears and stirs the heart is not worship.
 - Anywhere/anytime a person or people brings applause from the listeners, they are the focus of attention, NOT the Lord God.
 - The Lord God ONLY must be worshipped in spirit and truth.
- 4. To worship is the adoration of a redeemed people, occupied with THE LORD GOD, HIMSELF.
 - The unbeliever, the unsaved, the non-Christian knows nothing of being redeemed and therefore cannot worship in "spirit and in truth."
 - Israel learned how to worship God when they found themselves on the far shores of the Red Sea, having been delivered from slavery in Egypt.
- 5. Genuine, true worship is the new nature of the believer/Christian stirred into activity, turning to it's giver, the Lord God.
 - It is turning to the ONE who gave him/her eternal life.
 - It is the reborn/new heart crying out "Thanks be unto God for His unspeakable gift.."
 - It is sinners who have been cleansed by the blood of the Lord Jesus exclaiming thanksgiving, consciously, deliberately and with purpose.
- 6. Remember the woman, Mary, who knelt at the feet of Jesus and anointed His feet with an expensive ointment, then wiped His feet with her hair? (*John 12:2-3*)
 - Mary didn't come to hear a sermon or sit at Jesus' feet nor to meet Jesus' disciples, nor to relax and rest after a week's work. NO!
 - Mary came with a purpose and that was to pour out upon Jesus that which she had long kept treasured up, the most valuable of her possessions.
 - She did not think about Simon who had once had leprosy, nor her sister Martha or her brother Lazarus, NO!
 - Jesus filled her thoughts and adoration and honor to Him, pouring out her heart's devotion to Him was her focus. **THAT IS GENUINE, TRUE WORSHIP!**
- 7. The focus, center, subject of worship is what is important.
 - The three wise men brought rich gifts to Jesus upon hearing of His birth.
 - WORSHIP IS NOT COMING TO RECEIVE, BUT TO GIVE to the Lord God.

- 8. The object, person of worship is the Lord God.
 - Why is there so little overflowing of the heart with spontaneous expressions of adoration so hard to see, hear or find in most "worship" services?
 - Could it be that most people are there for the wrong reason? To HEAR a great sermon, to HEAR the beautiful choir? To SEE their friends?

III. HINDRANCES TO GENUINE, TRUE WORSHIP

- 1. Many "worshippers" lack assurance.
 - They are not sure of their salvation, not sure of having been forgiven.
- 2. Many "worshippers" fail to judge themselves by God's Word and have come to "worship" all stained with unconfessed sin.
 - Aaron and the priests were required to cleanse themselves before entering the Holy place.
- 3. Many "worshippers" come to Church services filled with worldliness.
 - Their minds and hearts are preoccupied with things of the world rather than with the Lord God and their worship of Him.
 - "This people honoureth Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me. Howbeit in vain do they worship Me."

CONCLUSION:

- 1. So now again, why are you here right now? To worship? Have you worshipped yet?
- 2. "God is Spirit; and they that worship Him, must worship Him in spirit and in truth."
 - "I am the way, the truth and the life, and no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me."
 - "This people honoureth Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me. Howbeit in vain do they worship Me.."
- 3. Not everybody can worship the Lord God. Do you qualify according to the Lord God's qualification?
- 4. If you don't qualify to worship the Lord God, what are you going to do about it?
