Psalm 31:15

1. IN LIFE:

2. IN DEATH:

CONCLUSION:

- 1. A note here, if you are not a part of God's family, and that can be only through His Son, Jesus, then right now, rush to Jesus Christ in trusting faith.
 - Think of all the wasted years of your life.
- 2. Christian, serve God without fear.
 - There is no cause to fear anybody. If our lives and our times are in God's hands, then why be afraid?
 - Christian, be bold, step out for the Lord.
- 3. We can trust God completely.
 - With our lives and times in God's hands, who could better manage them?
 - It is God who doeth all things well. (and nobody else)

 - Your (our) life (lives) and time (times) are in God's hands.
 - So why not be at peace and recognize God to be your God?
- 5. For us older Christians, let's try to not worry, try not to be apprehensive, try not to fret, try not to be overly concerned about things for our Lord who got us through our younger years when we didn't worry, is still in charge and if we didn't worry very much then, nothing has changed that really matters, so let's leave it to our Lord to do the worrying for us. Let's go on trusting Him.
