- 1. Eve had gotten separated from her husband, Adam and was alone in the garden.
  - Eve heard a "voice" and looking for it, she saw a radiant, beautiful, shimmering serpent.
- 2. Eve stopped to hear what the beautiful serpent (Satan) had to say.
  - What she heard should have cause her to walk away for she heard words that contradicted and questioned what she knew about God.
- 3. Anytime anyone stops to listen to what Satan has to say, there will be questions raised about God.
  - It is deadly for people to listen to evil for it will always create doubt about what God has said.
  - Eve was told that God didn't want her and her husband Adam to be as smart as He (God) was, so therefore to stay away from that certain tree.
  - Eve's mind began to question what God had told her and Adam.

# II. SATAN GOT EVE TO TAKE A LOOK AT THE FORBIDDEN TREE

- 1. Eve walked over to the tree God had them to leave alone and took a good look at it.
  - It was a very beautiful tree and had some very delectable looking fruit on it and she wondered why she had not noticed the tree before.
- 2. After looking the tree over real good, she began to wonder what she and Adam had been missing.
  - Why didn't God want them to have fruit from that tree, they could have fruit from every other tree, so why not this one?

- 1. Eve defied God! What happened then?
- 2. Unknown to her right then, she lost her soul, for it was no longer perfect and was now barred from all that was perfect, the Garden of Eden and Heaven.
  - Her soul had become dirty before God, totally unacceptable in His Holy place.
  - She was going to need God's mercy before her soul could ever have life again.
- 3. Eve lost her pleasure in God.
  - Before this dreadful hour in the Garden, she and Adam had enjoyed God's company every day, but now all is gone.
  - Nothing takes away one's pleasure with God as sin does.
- 4. Eve and Adam were removed from the Garden of Eden and the "gates" were shut behind them.
  - They were in a different world now, cold, indifferent, hard with the beautiful Garden, only a memory.
- 5. Eve lost all her happiness.
  - God killed animals to provide clothing for her and Adam.
  - Later her first born son was killed by his brother...
  - Because of Eve's sin in the Garden, untold millions of mothers through the centuries have also cried over the loss of killed sons.
  - If Eve had only not listened, if Eve had only not looked, if Eve had only not wanted, if Eve Eve had only not eaten of the fruit in the Garden that day. If, If, If. But she did!
