5. Matthew 2:1-2; 9-12

- Song - "We Three Kings"

- The men found the young child and gave gifts of gold, frankencense and Myrr.
- They left, going a different way as not to reveal to King Herod the location of the child.
- When the men did not return to tell King Herod about the child, he became angry and ordered all male babies under two years old to be killed.
