THE NEARNESS OF GOD

Jeremiah 23:24

- 4. How empty are the hopes of those with such thoughts:
 - deceive men, yes.
 - deceive own selves, yes.
 - deceive God, NO!
 - No matter how much care is taken to deceive, God sees and will bring fair judgment.
- 5. There is only one way for evil deeds to be missed by God and that is to have them covered with the blood of Jesus Christ. Blotted out as far as the East is from the West, Cast into the depth of the sea, etc.
- 6. It is vain to hope that by any other means than the blood of Jesus Christ that man can escape the wrath of God.
- 7. The Christian has many enemies hidden from view, yet in God's eyes they are not concealed nor is God deceived.
