THE SPIRIT AND OUR EMOTIONS

Genesis 1:1-2; 26-27

Introduction: An old saying entitled "Fact, Faith, Feelings" goes like this:

- The last two followed the first.

- Feelings got into trouble and that bothered Faith.

- Faith took its eyes off of Fact to help Feelings and got into difficulties itself UNTIL -

- Faith remembered it was to follow Fact and not to worry about Feelings - FOR -

- Sooner or later Feelings would catch up - MAYBE

The conclusion to this old saying:

- The TRUTH - our Faith is based on Facts, not on Feelings.

- the mistake is that Feelings don't always catch up.

So, where did the idea ever come from that Feelings have no place in worship or in the Christian's life?

- Christians are not made of steel! Emotions are not signs of immaturity, weakness or worldliness.

I. GOD MADE US IN HIS IMAGE

1. Genesis 1:1-2; 26-27

- We are made in the image and likeness of God - how so?

- God has a mind, intellect, knowledge, so do we.
- God has a will, volition, choices, so do we.
- God has a heart, emotions, feels things, so do we.

II. THE IMPORTANCE OF OUR FEELINGS

- Salvation is directed to the mind AND heart.
 1 Corinthians 2:9; 4:6; Romans 10:1, 9-10
- 2. Joy and cheer are of our feelings. (2 Corinthians 9:6-7)

3. Love is of our feelings. (2 Timothy 1:7; 1 John 4:19)

- 4. Fear is part of our feelings. (Proverbs 1:7)
- 5. Praise, bursts of admiration are part of our feelings. (Psalms)

6. Romans 12:9-18

- 7. There are "unusual" feelings.
 - Acts 17:16-17 being provoked and being burdened.
 - Acts 19:11-20
 - Emotions can soften hardened hearts and awaken deadened feelings.

III. SOME WARNINGS ABOUT FEELINGS

- 1. "Intellectualism," knowledge, can cause a loss of faith.
- 2. "Emotionalism," times of experiencing the sensational can cause a loss of faith.
- 3. "Fanaticism," excessive, intense devotion to things, people or a single minded concern can cause a loss of faith.
- 4. When the Holy Spirit is not in control, there is a tendency to go to other avenues of life/solutions.

CONCLUSION:

- 1. It has been said:
 - "Never trust your feelings..." Wrong!
 - There is a seasoned wisdom that gives discernment to enable us to trust our feelings or intentions.
 - -"Experience proves nothing..." Wrong!
 - Experience proves invaluable in listening for the Holy Spirit's voice.
 - "Experience is the best teacher..." Wrong!
 - Guided experience is good, it is reliable, but just any kind of experience is NOT the best teacher.
 - "Let your conscience be your guide..." Wrong!
 - What is the condition of one's conscience in the first place?
 - Dull, hardened, calloused, insensitive conscience is hardly a good guide.
- 2. God has given us a mind let us learn of God.
 - God has given us a will let us listen to and obey Him.
 - God has given us emotions l- let us open up and allow the Holy Spirit to lead us in beautiful ways of open expression of what is on the inside.
