THE TRUTH WE WILL NOT FACE

Luke 16:23

Introduction: There is a fact that people don't want to face however the person of clear vision faces facts because they ARE facts not necessarily because he/she likes them or wants them to be facts, but because they are facts, regardless.

Side-stepping the unpleasant in reality is one of the great feats of our generation. It is cowardly, hypocritical and disastrous, that which we do not like, we push aside as an illusion. By doing so we are plowing straight ahead into destruction. The fact that we don't want it to be there doesn't keep it from being there.

Our generation is continuously seeking for some comfortable religion, like an arm-chair religion. We all want to go to heaven but we want to stay on the road of selfishness, greed, worldliness and our own way. If we happen to miss heaven, we want to side-step Hell, therefore we do with God what some nations have done, throw Him out of the nation, forbid His Name to be spoken or used. We even try to throw Hell out along with God.

Did God really make us to be living souls? Is there really Hell? Heaven? Eternity?

I. THE FACT/TRUTH OF HELL IS WRITTEN IN OUR CONSCIENCE

- 2. The American Indian of our own country had never had a Bible, never heard the Gospel, never heard of Jesus Christ, yet there was not one tribe that did not believe in life after death.
- 3. Missionaries who came back from the islands of the Pacific, many having head-hunting tribes, related that all of the naked savages believed in life after death.
- 4. In the Egyptian tombs it has been discovered that those buried within the depths were found clutching sheaves of grain with corn, beans and other foods stored in jars around them thus they also believed in life after death.
 - Herein is a great universal fact! All people everywhere of every age believed and do believe in life after death.
- 5. If it is true that we shall live forever, then we should want to know something of the place we will be in. We should want to know something of the conditions under which we are to exist.

- 6. Now, when our generation arrives at this point, that there is life after death, we want to immediately bring it down to what we want it to be, down to our own level.
 - We leap to conclusions, start discussing what we heard about eternity from somebody when we were children.
 - The preachers of the past preached what the Bible said about eternity and it had a lot to say about Hell. They were bold enough to preach about it and that's more than can be said about most of today's preachers.
 - We can change the physical surrounds of Hell to suit our every whim, but the moment any of us, made in God's image, are banished forever to an existence of eternal selfishness, eternal sinfulness, eternal suffering, then at that moment our soul will know the meaning of what the Bible calls "fire and brimstone."

 - Here is where people depart from the truth. They wave hell aside, dismissing it completely. They say that God is love and that God so loved the world that He would not have nay man perish. - 3. Penalty is not cruel. Penalty is just. The sooner we realize that love is made possible by justice and that without a just God there can be no God of love, the sooner we will see the truth.
 - That is why Jesus Christ died on Calvary.
 - When God passed judgment on this world, then His love sent His Son, Jesus and Jesus started on His way toward the Cross. That is love.

III. JESUS CHRIST BORE OUR PENALTY AND TOOK CARE OF HELL FOR THE BELIEVER

- 1. The verdict still stands. The verdict is still written. It is not vicious, it is not hard, it is not cruel, IT IS JUST!

 - In Hell the rich man lifted up his eyes and saw what was going on about him. He felt the suffering and agony and he spoke, pleading for help. He then thought of his brothers who were on their way to where he was. He knew what had happened to him. He was conscious of his eternal condition.
