I. GOD STARTED CHRISTMAS BY GIVING HIS SON

- 1. Matthew 1:21 Luke 2:10-11
- 2. John 3:16
- 3. 2 Corinthians 9:6
- 4. Romans 6:23

II. MARY THEN GAVE SUBMISSION

- 1. Luke 1:38
- 2. Mary gave something other than a song or a story or a possession.
- 3. Mary gave her will, her soul, her life, her complete self.
- 4. Mary faced shame, misunderstanding, criticism, even possible death, but she obeyed and trusted God.

III. THEN THE ANGELS GAVE A TESTIMONY

- 1. Luke 2:13-14
- 2. The angels couldn't give a Savior.
- 3. They couldn't give silver or gold.
- 4. They couldn't tell anyone of the Savior's saving power from their own personal experience.
- 5. BUT, they could give a testimony, almost like a song.
 - They said in a loud voice, almost shouting to the glory of God and of good will among men.
 - What the angels did, all of us can do, we can speak, we can sing, "Glory to God, good will to men."
 - We can sing, "Oh for a thousand tongues to sing..."
 - We can sing, "I will sing the wondrous story..."

IV. THE SHEPHERDS GAVE A STORY

- 1. Luke 2:17
- 2. The shepherds heard what the angels said.
- 3. The shepherds believed what they heard.
- 4. The shepherds then went to see for themselves what the angels had told them.,
- 5. They saw and then hurried away to tell the good news of what they had seen.
- 6. We can be like the shepherds for we have heard the good news, we have seen and now know for ourselves, therefore we can proclaim the good news everywhere, too.

V. LATER ON THE WISE MEN GAVE WHAT THEY HAD

- 1. Matthew 2:11
- 2. The wise men came looking for the King, the Savior.
- 3. When they found Him, they then worshipped Him.
- 4. The wise men showed their devotion and reverence in giving the best gifts they had.
- 5. We sing a song about of how to imitate what the wise men did:

"Give of your best to the master, Give Him first place in your heart, Give Him first place in your service, Consecrate every part. Give, and to you shall be given, God His beloved Son gave, Gratefully seeking to serve Him, Give Him the best that you have..."
