WHY SO MANY ARE LOST

Matthew 22:1-14

Introduction: The greatest wonder of all is that God loved us, Jesus Christ died for us and Salvation is offered to us FREE, but mankind is unwilling to accept it! Why?

- "ameleo" in Greek means to neglect, to be unconcerned, to disregard, to be indifferent.
 It is a frame of mind.
 "mello" in Greek is to be about, to intend, to have purpose, to have in mind.
- 2. Man makes light of Him that made NOT light of him. Think about how much God and Jesus have done for mankind (John 3:16).
- 3. Man makes light of the masterpiece of God SALVATION.
- 4. Man makes light of matters of greatest moments such as being confronted with Jesus Christ, times when the Gospel is being presented or has been heard.
- 5. Man never considers WHO sends the message that it is God, Himself.
- 6. Whose salvation is man making fun of? Others? Is it not his/her very own?
- 7. Some profess to believe but do not actually believe in Jesus and still make light of it and that falseness can be seen in their lives.
- 8. Christians, what are the things you think more important than Jesus Christ? Is it a "better" friend? Is it a "better way" of life? Can all the things you pursue save you?
- 9. To make light of Jesus Christ is to insure an eternity in Hell. Why did Jesus die in the first place?
- 10. The time will come when Jesus Christ will not be made light of and it will be too late to change one's mind.
- 11. God will not give you that salvation you have made light of on that great day of judgment. Right now there is opportunity but not then.
- 12. What hope do you have to escape God's wrath without Jesus Christ?
- 13. STOP making light of the things of God and His Son, Jesus Christ.
